

WIFE, A WIDOW A WIFE ALL IN TEN DAYS

First Husband After a Quick Courtship Died With A Broken Heart

AW RIVAL AND COMMITTED SUICIDE

Wife Promptly Became the Wife of the Man She Had Jilted

Omaha, Neb., Oct. 19.—Married to women within less than three weeks, becoming the wife of one ten days after the suicide of the other, this is the unique matrimonial record of young Mrs. Henry G. Cushing, a former Sioux City woman.

Mrs. Cushing's first husband came with her to Omaha from Sioux City a week ago last Tuesday, and a few hours after his arrival here he committed suicide in the doorway of the first Presbyterian church by drinking carbolic acid. Gripped in one of his hands was a note he had written
