CENTENNIAL COMMISSION

Selected by Chairman Huntington Brown—Representative Citizens and All Good Workers.

At the meeting of the Richland County Historical Society held last week, a Centennial Commission was created to make arrangements for a glorious and fitting Centennial of Mansfield's Centennial in 1908. Hon. Huntington Brown was made chairman of this commission and given power to appoint a committee of from 7 to 9 persons, including a commission secretary, to assist him in the work. Today Mr. Brown made known his appointments as follows:

A. J. Baughman, secretary; Rev. Father F. A. Schreiber, Capt. A. C. Cummins, R. G. Hancock, M. B. Bushnell, Chas. H. Voegelé, Peter Bissman, T. B. Martin. Two others will be appointed later, completing the commission.

The appointments made by Mr. Brown are most excellent ones, including as they do, representative business and professional men of the city, and it is safe to say that with such a capable committee as this in charge there will be effective work done and that the celebration will be a success. It remains for the citizens of Mansfield to put their shoulders to the wheel and assist the committee in making the celebration of Mansfield's centennial such an event as will be remembered till the time rolls round for the celebration of the second centennial, in 2008.
